Thank you for your request dated 4 December 2023 under the Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act 2002 (FOISA), please accept my apology for our delayed response.

For reference, you requested.

RFI 1: "How many prison officer staff have been disciplined in each of the past three financial years, 2021-2022, 2022-2023 and so far in 2023? And what were the reasons recorded?"

RFI 2: "How many prison officer staff have been sacked in each of the past three financial years, 2021-2022, 2022-2023 and so far in 2023? And what were the reasons recorded?"

RFI 3: "We request all written and/or electronic correspondence and/or minutes between the SPS and the Scottish Government pertaining to overcrowding in the past two years, 2022-2023 and so far in 2023."

RFI 4: "We request all written and/or electronic correspondence and/or minutes between the SPS and the Scottish Government pertaining to levels of remand in the past two years."

RFI 5: "We request the waiting list figures and/or average wait times for individual prison programmes. Can this be broken down by prison?"

RFI 6: "How many prisoners are on the waiting list for the Generic Programme Assessment?"

We have now completed our search for the information you requested.

We do endeavour to provide information wherever possible, however providing specific numbers for instances less than 5, may lead to the subsequent identification of the employee(s) concerned. It is for this reason an exemption under Section 38(1) (b) (personal information) of FOI(S)A has been applied to some of the information requested.

RFI 3 & 4 Response: Due to the number of people involved in the management of those in our care to provide this information would require a wide-ranging search over the date range requested, involving a considerably high number of staff to search for any emails that refer to the remand population and overcrowding.

Under section 12 of the Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act 2012 (FOI(S)A), we are not required to comply with a request for information if the cost of doing so would be estimated to breach the upper cost limit, which is currently set at £600. It is our assessment that the cost of locating, retrieving, and providing the requested information would exceed the upper cost limit, as this would involve a large number of staff carrying out a search for this information and provide any findings.

RFI 5 Response: The table below outlines prisoners listed for each Offending Behaviour Programme delivered across SPS. We do not hold average times for access to a space on a programme and to calculate this would be a significant task which would be out-with the upper cost limit of an FOI request.
