**RFI 1:** How many instances of fire-raising of vehicles have occurred within Scottish Prisons grounds (including privately managed ones) in the last 5 years? And how many of those occurred this year? I ask this because I note Mr Findlay MP asked this question earlier this year and was told only 1 occurred this year in a private prison, however I understand 6 cars alone were subjected to fire-raising in January in a prison?
